

3. Transportation to Galway and in Galway


- From Shannon Airport Buses are available from Shannon Airport directly to Galway city; travel time is approximately 1.5 hours. Check out Bus Eireann's timetables to plan how you can get to and from Shannon Airport. Bus Timetables are available here. When booking your tickets, your starting location is Shannon Airport and ending location is Galway Coach Station. This route is number 51. Tickets cost approximately €10-€15 one way.
- From Dublin Airport Citylink offer bus services directly to Galway; travel time is
 approximately 2.5 hours. Click here to book with Citylink Routes 760, 761 and 763
 connect Dublin Airport to Galway. Click here to plan your trip or book tickets and see
 alternative services for travel.
- From Cork Airport Tickets for coach services Galway can be purchased online at
 citylink.ie while standby tickets can be purchased directly from the coach driver (cash
 and card accepted). Bus timetables can be viewed on www.citylink.ie. From bus stop C
 at Cork Airport, customers can take Citylink service 251 which stops at Galway



Coach Station. Citylink operate eight daily services connecting Cork Airport with Galway.

Galway is well-connected and easy to navigate:

Bus: University of Galway has great access to frequent buses, going to and from the city
centre and surrounding areas. <u>Galway Coach Station</u> in the city centre connects Galway
to the rest of Ireland! Pay with contactless payment or purchase a <u>Leap Card</u>, which can
be topped up and will give toy discounted rates for travel on buses and trains in Ireland.





- **Train:** The Galway Ceannt Train Station is located in city centre just off Eyre Square (1.2km walk from the university or accessible by bus/taxi). Train information can be found on the Irish Rail website.
- Bicycle and E-Bicycle Rental: Bicycles are widely available to rent through <u>TFI</u> App can
 be downloaded on the <u>App Store</u> or the <u>Google Play</u> store to help on station locations,
 bike and stand availability, route planning.
- Taxi: Taxis are readily available across the city and can be arranged online and on apps
 like FreeNow and Uber.
