For the final year International Development subject you need 30 ECTs; 15 ECTs will be allocated to Core modules so you must select 3 optional modules, of which only 1 module can be a transdisciplinary module.

Transdisciplinary modules

Transdisciplinary modules offer students something new in their university learning experience through innovative coursework. These modules will enhance students' professional skills, broaden their knowledge and offer a more holistic learning experience designed by experts from across the university, with input from our enterprise, as well as local community partners.

Students selecting such modules are only allowed to select one module per subject per year. They can select a maximum of two such modules per year provided they only select one per subject e.g. one in International Development and one in History. Furthermore, students must not sign up to take the same module in another subject or in any subsequent semester after you've taken it once - e.g., if you take "Megatrends" in Semester 1 of your second year, you cannot take this module again at any stage of your coursework (in semester 2 of second year, or in any semester of 3rd or 4th year, in the same or any other subject). Each individual module is one time only.
