

YEAR 3 OPTIONS

- You select International Development as a subject
- If you are a Joint Honours Student, you can stay on the 3 year track and complete the BA in two more years
- If you are a Joint Honours Student with a language, you will have a 3rd year language placement
- If you are a Joint Honours Student and you wish to go on an overseas studies study placement, please let me know as I am planning overseas placements over the next 6 months.
 - It will require a transfer to the BA International Stream to It would be good to have an indication of demand for overseas placements.
 - There are non-EU placements in Japan and the USA. If you are interested in these, there may be some early planning in semester 1 next year, so let me know. European placements via ERASMUS are easier.
- If you are on a 4 year denominated degree and you plan to keep up International Development, let me know, so I can liaise with your other subject to plan the placement.
- Although not coordinated by me, for those who source a work placement, there is a possibility to do so.
 - However again, let me know early, so I can plan the various permissions required by the University. There is a risk assessment, so it would be important to organise this early
