## French Language I

Course code FR105

Semester 1&2 No. of Hours weekly **4** 

Module description:

The aim of this component of the module is to review the basics and provide students with a solid grounding in written & spoken French. Via a variety of activities and exercises pitched at level A2.2 $\rightarrow$ B1.1, students will acquire the necessary comprehension and expression skills (written & oral) to begin to engage with the reality and relevance of contemporary France and the wider Frenchspeaking world.

Teaching and learning methods:

Compréhension et expression orale I – Multimedia Laboratory (1 hour); Langue écrite I – Translation, Grammar & Written Expression (2 hours) and Conversation / Discussion I (1 hour) with Francophone Language Tutor.

Methods of assessment and examination:

End of year 2-hour Written Examination, Continuous Assessment (All year) & end of year Oral Examination.

### Introduction to the Civilisation and Economy of France and the French-speaking world

Module description:

An introduction to the economic, cultural, social and political life of France and the French-speaking world. The aim of this component of the module is to give students a general overview of and relevant insights into society, current affairs, economics and politics in France and the wider French-speaking world in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

#### Teaching and learning methods:

One seminar and one tutorial weekly. Students will also read *Tintin & Astérix* albums from the library as part of an introduction to reading in French and will have the opportunity of achieving a Digital Badge for the compilation of a Cultural Passport.

### Methods of assessment and examination:

End of year 2-hour Written Examination & regular Individual *Exposés*.
