



Were you assigned a new ID number, i.e. 26xxxxxx ID number when you accepted your offer?

It is the University of Galway's policy to retain your full student history under your first or old University ID Number therefore you **SHOULD NOT** register under your newly assigned CAO or Postgrad Application number.

If you did not specify in your application that you are a past student you must now contact Admissions to get your ID numbers merged

- If you are undergraduate (CAO) – contact admissions@universityofgalway.ie
- If you are postgraduate – contact postgradadmissions@universityofgalway.ie (taught courses) pgresearch@universityofgalway.ie (research courses)

What are the implications if your numbers are not merged **before** you start your course?

It will affect:

- Your fees record
- You may lose University of Galway emails post merge
- You will lose everything you have on Canvas e.g. assignments, notes, results, blogs etc post merge
- You will need a new ID card
- No access to the Library
- It will cause confusion on course class lists, SU card, Socs and club etc
